The following Housing Support projects were approved in 2024-25. Two organisations received funding for a total amount of \$16,601.90

Organisation	Project	Amount approved
Community Queensland Ltd	The project will provide new mattresses and bedding to individuals and families entering social and community housing. The project aims to reduce the financial burden on low-income households furnishing their new home and enabling a more seamless transition out of homelessness.	\$9,111.90
Pets In The Park Incorporated	The project will provide a volunteer training and education program focusing on homelessness, mental health, suicide prevention and domestic violence. The project aims to enhance the volunteer's skills and knowledge to provide more comprehensive support to vulnerable individuals.	\$7,490.00

2023-24 recipients

The following Housing Support projects were approved in 2023-24. Four organisations received funding for a total amount of \$21,340.00.

Organisation	Project	Amount approved
Community Queensland Ltd	The project will provide material aid in the form of phones, TV's, headphones to households at the beginning of their tenancies to assist with digital inclusion and communication. The mobile support team from HART4000 (Community) will provide ongoing tenancy sustainment support and outreach to the household, ensuring the longevity and success of new tenancies.	\$9,089.60

Brisbane Housing Company Limited	The project will provide barista training to vulnerable boarding room and community housing residents who currently have limited access to employment, training and participation opportunities in the community. The project will focus strongly on nurturing hospitality and customer service soft skills.	\$4,800.00
Village Church	The project will provide a weekly pop in cafe that will focus on connection, empowerment, life skills, employability and social inclusion.	\$4,000.00
139 Club Limited trading as 3rd Space	The project will provide practical financial support to assist vulnerable people with sustaining their tenancies.	\$3,450.40
