Purpose

This funding recognises the valuable contribution that seniors make to Brisbane and its community life.

Donations are available to assist with the following activities:

- Social outings and bus trips for Brisbane seniors; or
- The cost of celebrations such as Christmas parties for Brisbane seniors.

Eligibility

These donations are available to clubs and groups providing activities for seniors that are not funded by other sources. Seniors groups that are part of other organisations can also apply.

Only one application per organisation, club or group will be considered.

The donation is not available for activities that have already taken place.

Eligible organisations, clubs and groups must have a current operational bank account.

Donation payments cannot be made to individuals or business accounts. If your club does not have a bank account you must arrange for another organisation to sponsor your activity. If you have arranged for a sponsor, please attach a letter to your application from the sponsoring organisation that confirms their willingness to support your activity.

The meeting location for organisations, clubs and groups must be within the Brisbane City Council Local Government Area to be eligible for this donation program.

Applications for donations will be prioritised as follows:

- Priority One – Organisations, clubs or groups run by seniors for the benefit of seniors
- Priority Two – Community organisations, clubs or groups supporting seniors
- Priority Three– Hobby and recreation organisations, clubs or groups that have a majority or all seniors members
- Priority Four – Welfare services for seniors.

Amounts

The donation amount available for trips and celebrations depends on the level of demand for donations. Donations may range from \$100 to \$300 depending on the number of applications received.

The number of participants will also be considered in the allocation of donation amounts.

Payment

Donations will be paid to successful organisations, clubs and groups by way of direct deposit electronic funds transfer to the applicant organisation's bank account.

Bank account details need to be provided on the application form, or the sponsor's bank account if one has been nominated. It is recommended that you consult with your Treasurer to confirm account details.

It is important that the correct account details are supplied to Council at the time of application. Any variation in BSB or bank account number from the submitted application will result in delays while new details are confirmed prior to payment being made.

Making Application

You can apply for a donation online, send an application by mail, or hand deliver it.

1. Online applications

Council has an online application system which allows you to submit your application through Smartygrants.

To submit an online application to the Seniors Celebration Donation, go to brisbane.qld.gov.au and search for 'Community Grants'. You will find the Seniors Celebration Donation listed on this page, including a copy of the program guidelines and a link to the online application form.

The online application system will allow you to save, develop and print out your application before you submit it. Support material can also be attached to your online application.

2. Mailing or delivering an application

- Applications should be typed or hand written in block letters.
- Late and faxed applications will not be accepted.
- Applications may be mailed or hand delivered.
