## PUBLIC NOTICE MINOR AND ADMINISTRATIVE AMENDMENT PACKAGE O

At its meeting on 1 August 2023, Brisbane City Council adopted a minor and administrative amendment to *Brisbane City Plan 2014* (Minor and administrative amendment package O). The amendment applies citywide and will commence on 1 September 2023.

The purpose and general effect of Minor and administrative amendment package O is to:

- increase Brisbane's resilience to flooding by updating the Creek/waterway flood planning areas on the Flood overlay map to reflect the flood study for Bulimba Creek.
- update the planning scheme to reflect the *Planning Regulation 2017* requirement for a planning scheme to make development on a local heritage place to be assessable development.
- update the planning scheme to reflect the relevant sections of the *Queensland Heritage Act 1992* for exemption certificates.
