

*Planning Act 2016***BRISBANE CITY COUNCIL
ADOPTION OF A TAILORED AMENDMENT –
MOUNT GRAVATT CENTRE SUBURBAN RENEWAL PRECINCT PLAN**

At its meeting on 18 August 2026, Brisbane City Council adopted a tailored amendment to *Brisbane City Plan 2014* and changes to planning scheme policies, to introduce the Mount Gravatt Centre Suburban Renewal Precinct Plan including consequential amendments to the Holland Park—Tarragindi district and Mount Gravatt corridor neighbourhood plans and to include areas currently outside of these neighbourhood plan areas. The amendment applies to parts of the suburbs of Mount Gravatt, Mount Gravatt East, Upper Mount Gravatt, Holland Park and Holland Park West and includes consequential changes to the wider Holland Park—Tarragindi district and Mount Gravatt corridor neighbourhood plan areas. The amendment will commence on 18 September 2026.

The purpose and general effect of the amendment is to:

- amend the Mount Gravatt corridor neighbourhood plan code as it applies to the above suburbs.
- amend the Strategic framework, zones, neighbourhood plan and overlay maps to respond to the finer grained planning for the area.
- amend the Structure planning and Infrastructure design planning scheme policies to update references to the Mount Gravatt corridor neighbourhood plan.

ADOPTION OF MINOR AND ADMINISTRATIVE
AMENDMENT PACKAGE W**

At its meeting on 18 August 2026, Brisbane City Council adopted a minor and administrative amendment and an administrative planning scheme policy amendment (Minor and administrative amendment package W) to *Brisbane City Plan 2014*. The amendment applies citywide and will commence on 18 September 2026.

The purpose and general effect of the amendment is to:

- update sections of the planning scheme to reflect the *Planning Regulation 2017* requirements for particular types of development that have a prescribed category of assessment or that cannot be made assessable.
- make site-specific changes to overlay mapping to reflect development approvals, correct inconsistencies and generally reflect site-based circumstances.
- refine wording, correct typography and enhance formatting to improve the effectiveness and usability of the planning scheme.
