- If Council proceeds with a quote, Council will select the quote which it considers to be the most advantageous outcome for Council (not necessarily the lowest priced quote).
- Council is not obliged to proceed with any quote and may amend, suspend or cancel this RFQ process at any time.
- Your quote must be valid for at least six weeks from the date of receipt by Council, unless otherwise agreed with Council prior to submitting your quote.
- Your quote may be removed from consideration if it does not comply with the requirements of the RFQ or you discuss the RFQ, your quote or Council's evaluation with the media or any Councillor or Council officer, with the exception of Council's contact officer and any officer nominated by Council's contact officer.
- Council will not reimburse any costs associated with your participation in the RFQ process.
