Our natural environment is one of the things that sets us apart from other cities, and our parks and playgrounds have helped shape Brisbane's incredible lifestyle.

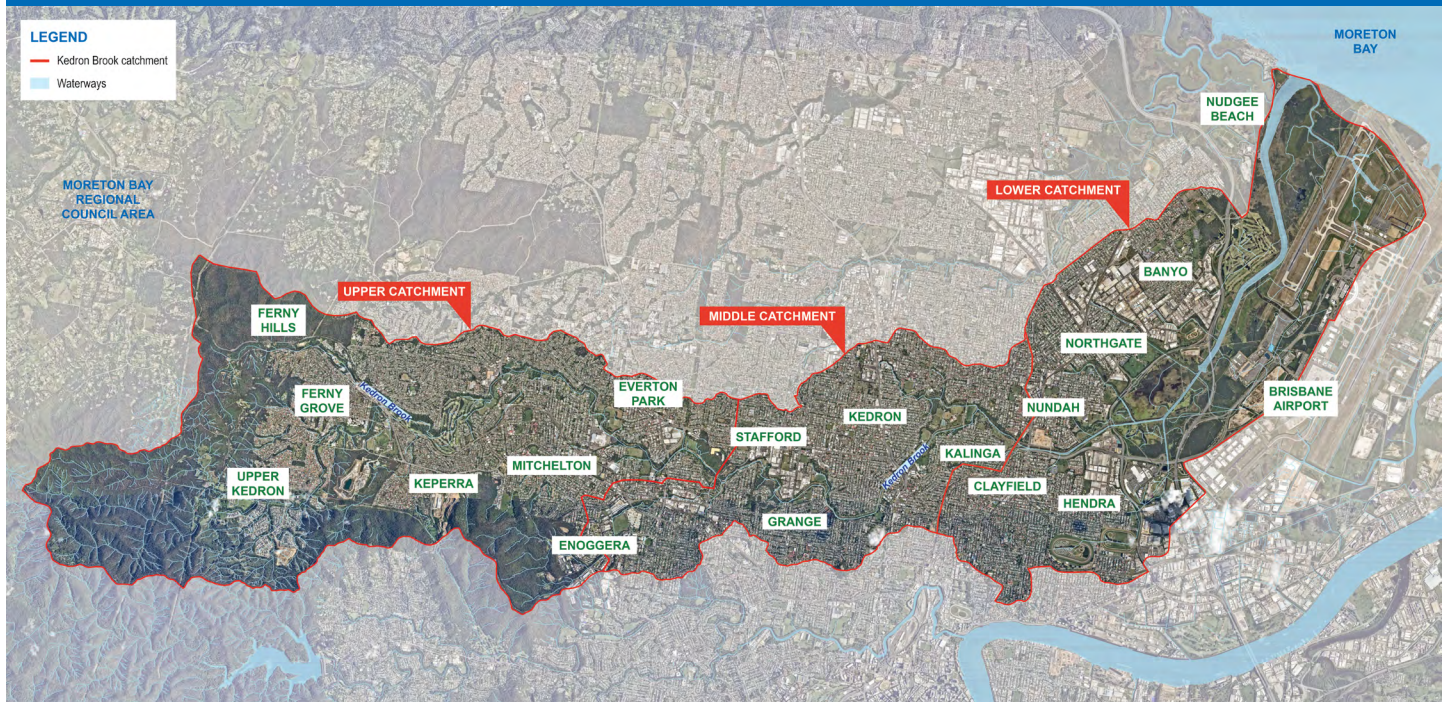
That's why we're working on a long-term vision for Kedron Brook and want to hear how we can make it even better.
