

Drive-up trading conditions



Dedicated to a better Brisbane

When using a drive-up site, Mobile Traders must follow the rules below.

Where you can park

- trade only from a lawful parking space on a Council-controlled road where parking is permitted, excluding State-controlled, Federal-controlled or privately owned roads

Distance requirements

Mobile Traders must keep at least 30 metres away (measured in a straight line along the street, not through buildings, from the closest point of the Mobile Food Vehicle) from:

- a residential premises, where the Mobile Food Vehicle is positioned on the same side of the road
- a school or library during operating hours, where the Mobile Food Vehicle is positioned on the same side of the road
- the main entrance or outdoor dining area of an existing fixed food business that principally sells similar food or beverages
- a Trading Location (a pre-approved, bookable site under this program)
- a food business or Mobile Food Vehicle authorised to operate under another Council consent program

Trading hours

Mobile Traders may only trade during the following hours:

- **Brisbane City CBD area:** 7:00am to 3:00am the following day (Monday to Sunday)
- **all other areas:** 7:00am to 10:00pm (Monday to Sunday)
- **maximum stay:** up to 5 hours at any one location per day (including set-up and pack-up)

Operational requirements

Mobile Traders must:

- follow all road rules and ensure the Mobile Food Vehicle and any towing vehicle are parked lawfully at all times
- not obstruct footpaths, cycleways or driveways
- not trade within the South Bank Precinct, being the area bounded by Grey Street, Vulture Street, Dock Street and the Brisbane River, including South Bank Parklands and all adjoining Council or State-controlled land within that boundary
- continue to comply with all other conditions of the Consent

Note: If a written agreement exists between the Mobile Trader and an affected fixed food business, the 30-metre restriction relating to that fixed food business does not apply.

Important: These requirements summarise the conditions that apply to drive-up trading. In the event of any inconsistency, the conditions of the Consent take precedence.
