Local Law	Purpose and general effect
<i>Advertising Devices Local Law 2021</i>	The regulate advertising devices in the local government area.
<i>Permitted Advertising Devices Designation</i>	To designate certain advertising devices as permitted advertising devices.
<i>Advertising Devices Design and Assessment Rule</i>	To categorise advertising devices and set conditions attaching to those categories
<i>Amplified Music Venues Local Law 2006</i>	To regulate noise from amplified music played at amplified music venues in various precincts of Brisbane, and to outline the detail of the permit regime Council applies.
<i>Animals Local Law 2017</i>	To regulate and manage the keeping and control of animals.
<i>Ballymore Traffic Area Local Law 2001</i>	To create, and regulate parking within, the Ballymore Traffic Area.
<i>Caravan Parks and Relocatable Home Parks Local Law 2000</i>	To ensure that Residential Parks are properly operated and maintained in order to safeguard the health, safety, and amenity of its residents and of the community and the environment in which the Residential Parks are situated.
<i>Caravan Parks and Relocatable Home Parks Subordinate Local Law 2000</i>	To assist the implementation of the <i>Caravan Parks and Relocatable Home Parks Local Law 2000</i> .
<i>Dutton Park Parking Control Area Local Law 2006</i>	To create, and regulate parking within, the Dutton Park Parking Control Area.
<i>Events Local Law 2022</i>	To regulate certain events that are undertaken in the local government area and to safeguard the health, safety and amenity of people attending those events and the community in which those events are undertaken.
<i>Assessable Events Rule</i>	To set out information to support an application for, and provide types of conditions that may apply for, assessable events
<i>Self-Assessable Events Rule</i>	To set out the process to apply for and obtain a permit, and the types of conditions that apply for self-assessable events
<i>Footpath Dining Local Law 2011</i>	To regulate footpath dining so that it is carried out in a way which ensures the safety of pedestrians, diners, road users; the protection of Council assets and infrastructure; and the maintenance of the amenity of the surrounding area.
<i>(The) Gabba Traffic Area Local Law 2000</i>	To create, and regulate parking within, the Gabba Traffic Area.
<i>Health, Safety and Amenity Local Law 2021</i>	To protect standards of community health and safety and to enhance local amenity.
<i>Health, Safety and Amenity Subordinate Local Law 2012</i>	To designate areas of the city in which the duty to maintain building appearances will apply.
<i>Heavy and Long Vehicle Parking Local Law 1999</i>	To protect the safety, environment and amenity of residential land by g for the restriction of parking of heavy and long vehicles near residential land.
<i>Lang Park Traffic Area Local Law 2002</i>	To create and regulate parking within the Lang Park Traffic Area.
<i>Meetings Local Law 2001</i>	To provide for the orderly and proper conduct of Council and Committee meetings.
<i>Natural Assets Local Law 2003</i>	To protect the biodiversity values of the City including the habitat and ecological requirements of native flora and fauna; to preserve natural landforms; to facilitate the retention of the landscape character of the City; to facilitate the retention of the historical and cultural values of the City by restricting indiscriminate clearing of vegetation; to control hazardous vegetation; and to control and manage pest vegetation.
<i>Paid Parking Machines Local Law 2003</i>	To provide for paid parking by pre-paid voucher; and to regulate parking in paid parking machine zones.

Local Law	Purpose and general effect
<i>Public Land and Council Assets Local Law 2014</i>	To: (a) provide for the management and regulation of activities in or on— (i) Council parks, open spaces, bushland and conservation areas; and (ii) malls in the City; and (iii) roads; and (iv) other Council assets; to optimise the benefit derived by the public from that land; and (b) protect Council assets; and (c) provide for Council consent to be required for certain activities; and (d) provide a procedure for the removal or confiscation of articles or vehicles situated on Council assets contrary to this or another law, and the storage, return or disposal of those articles or vehicles.
<i>Queensland Tennis Centre Parking Area Local Law 2009</i>	To create, and regulate parking within, the Queensland Tennis Centre Parking Area.
<i>Regulated Parking Permit Local Law 1996</i>	To provide a parking permit system for residents in regulated parking permit scheme areas, visitors and carers of those residents, certain vessel occupiers, and car-share operators that will allow the parking of their vehicles in certain regulated parking permit scheme areas contrary to an official traffic sign regulating parking by time.
<i>Robertson/Macgregor Traffic Area Regulated Parking Local Law 1996</i>	To create, and regulate parking within, the Robertson/Macgregor Traffic Area.
<i>St Lucia Traffic Area Regulated Parking Local Law 1998</i>	To create, and regulate parking within, the St Lucia Traffic Area.

• Chapter 6 Streets, Bridges, Culverts, Etc.	To regulate allotment identification for pieces, parcels or subdivisions of land through the determination of house numbering

• Chapter 10 Transport	To regulate bus fares and passengers
• Chapter 11 Sundry Matters Relating to Structures	To regulate buildings left incomplete after commencement of building work
