Brisbane Environment Centres – ‘Be a Platypal Colouring Competition’ terms and conditions

These terms and conditions set out all of the information regarding the 2026 Brisbane Environment Centres – Be a Platypal Colouring Competition (the **Terms and Conditions**).

1. The Promoter of this Competition is Brisbane City Council ABN 72 002 765 795, acting through its Natural Environment, Water and Sustainability branch whose principal offices are at Brisbane Square, 266 George Street, Brisbane (the **Promoter**).
2. Information on how to enter this Competition, as contained on the Promoter's website or in other materials published by the Promoter, forms part of these Terms and Conditions. To the extent of any inconsistency or conflict, these Terms and Conditions will take precedence.
3. Competition entry is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
4. **Prizes:** each prize consists of one (1) **Wildlife of Greater Brisbane handbook**; and (1) Platypus soft toy (together a **Prize**). A total of two (2) Prizes are available to be won, with one (1) Prize awarded in the **Children Under 8 Years** category and one (1) Prize awarded in the **Children 8 Years and Over** category.

The Prize is not exchangeable or transferable and cannot be redeemed for cash. Any additional expenses incurred by the Prize winner by participating in this Competition are the responsibility of the Prize winner.

5. **No assignment:** Prizes must be redeemed by the relevant Prize winner (or the Prize winner's parent or guardian on the Prize winner's behalf). The Prize winner may not assign or otherwise transfer the benefit of the Prize to another person.
6. **The Competition period:** This Competition will open at 9:00am AEST Monday 10 August 2026 and close at 11:59pm AEST Wednesday 30 September 2026.

Entries will only be accepted during this time.

7. **How to enter:** To enter the Competition, entrants must:
 - a) Send the Colouring Image, downloaded from the Promoter's website (the **Colouring Image**), completed by the entrant via email to dcbbc@brisbane.qld.gov.au; or
 - b) Physically deliver to or hand in person their completed Competition image at: Downfall Creek Bushland Centre located at 815 Rode Rd, Chermside West QLD 4032.

8. **Contact details:** The contact details of the entrant's parent or guardian (including full name, relationship to entrant, email address and contact phone number), as well as the entrant's date of birth, must be noted legibly on the entrant's physical Competition entry or set out in the accompanying email to the Competition entry. These contact details will be used to contact the entrant in the event that they win a Prize and determine the category of the Competition entry.
9. **Entries:** For each entrant:
 - (a) the completion of one (1) Colouring Image will equate to one (1) Competition entry; and
 - (b) a maximum of one (1) Competition entry can be submitted to and accepted by the Promoter
10. **Eligibility:** To be eligible to enter this Competition, a person must:
 - (a) not be an employee or contracted staff of the Promoter; and
 - (b) be under the age of 18 years old at the time of Competition entry.
11. **Competition Draws:** The Prize winners will be drawn by an officer of the Promoter by randomly selecting the one (1) eligible Competition entry from each category, being the **Children Under 8 Years** category and the **Children 8 Years and Over** category.
12. **Winner Notification:** The Prize winners will be notified by email or phone call, to the Prize winner's parent or guardian, by an officer of the Promoter by 5:00pm AEST on the subsequent Tuesday to each Prize draw.
13. **Prize claim:** To claim the Prize, the Prize winner (or the Prize winner's parent or guardian on the Prize winner's behalf) must notify the relevant officer of the Promoter of the Prize winner's preferred Participating Library to collect their Prize. The Prize must be claimed by 5:00pm AEST on the date falling two (2) weeks after the Promoter's officer notifies the winner about the prize (**Prize Claim Date**).
14. **Re-Draw:** If a winner (or the Prize winner's parent or guardian on the Prize winner's behalf) does not claim the Prize by the respective Prize Claim Date, that winner (as originally drawn) will cease to be the winner and will not be entitled to claim the Prize.
15. The Promoter will be entitled to draw a new winner and provide a period of time for that new winner to claim the Prize. If that new winner fails to claim the Prize in the applicable period of time, that new winner will cease to be the winner and will not be entitled to claim the Prize. This redraw process may continue to apply on any number of occasions (at the discretion of the Promoter), until such time as the Prize is claimed by a winner within the applicable period, or the Promoter decides, in its absolute discretion, not to re-draw the Prize.
16. The Promoter, in its absolute discretion, reserves the right to not award the Prize to any entrant, including, without limitation, if the Prize is not claimed by the Prize Claim Date or any subsequent period provided for a new winner to claim the Prize, or the Promoter decides, in its absolute discretion, not to re-draw the Prize.

17. **Copyright and privacy:** By entering the Competition, the entrant, as the creator of the Competition image, grants to Council the right to:
- (a) maintain a copy of the Colouring Image for archival purposes;
 - (b) publish the Colouring Image on any Council publications, website and social media platforms; and
 - (c) allow the Colouring Image to be reproduced and/or exhibited by Council and its subsidiaries and related companies for any purpose.
18. Council will acknowledge and give attribution to the entrant as creator of the Colouring Image in all reproductions of the image as the creator of the Colouring Image.
19. Whilst Council will take care to ensure the quality and integrity of the reproduced Colouring Image, the entrant acknowledges that adapting the original Colouring Image for presentation may result in enlargements and variations to the image.
20. **No Liability of Promoter:** The Promoter accepts no responsibility whatsoever for late, misplaced, lost or ineligible entries. The Promoter makes no representations or warranties as to the quality, suitability or merchantability of the Prize. To the extent permitted by law, the Promoter is not liable for:
- (a) any loss or damage whatsoever which is suffered (including but not limited to direct, indirect loss, economic loss, special loss or consequential loss which includes but is not limited to loss of actual or anticipated profit, loss of goodwill, loss of reputation, loss of opportunity, loss of savings and/or loss of contract); or
 - (b) without limiting paragraph (a), any personal injury or death or loss of, or damage to, property in connection with entry into the Competition or acceptance of the Prize,

howsoever such liability arises and whether arising in tort (including without limitation in negligence), for breach of contract (including without limitation under any indemnity), under statute, in equity or otherwise.

21. To the extent all or any part of condition 20 is found to be contrary to the Australian Consumer Law, but the Australian Consumer Law otherwise permits the Promoter to limit the Promoter's liability to the value of the Prize or the resupply of the Prize, then the liability of the Promoter is instead limited, at the Promoter's election, to either the value of the Prize or the resupply of the Prize.
22. **Important – Privacy Consent:** By entering this Competition, the entrant's parent or guardian on the entrant's behalf acknowledges and consents to:
- (a) the entrant's personal information, including their name, email and phone number, and their own personal information, including their full name, relationship to entrant, email address and contact phone number, being collected and stored on the Promoter's database in accordance with the Promoter's [privacy policy](#) for the purpose of this Competition; and
 - (b) the entrant's first name and age being published by the Promoter as part of the attribution as creator of the Colouring Image, with the Colouring Image on any Council publications, website and social media platforms to be reproduced

and/or where it is otherwise exhibited by Council and its subsidiaries and related companies for any purpose.

23. **Force Majeure:** If for any reason this Competition is not capable of running as planned (including due to infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the Promoter), which corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Competition, the Promoter reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to take any action that may be available, and to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the Competition. The Promoter reserves the right in its sole discretion to disqualify all entries from any individual(s) who tampers with, or benefits from tampering with, the entry process which as a result corrupts or affects the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the Competition.
24. In the case of the intervention of any outside agent or event which naturally changes the result or prevents or hinders its determination, including but not limited to vandalism, power failures, tempests, natural disasters, acts of God, civil unrest, or strikes, the Promoter may in its absolute discretion cancel the Competition and recommence it from the start on the same conditions (with necessary amendments to key dates).
25. The Promoter does not claim responsibility for any changes to the Competition including change in location, rescheduling or cancellation.
26. The Promoter reserves the right to modify these Terms and Conditions at any time and to cancel or amend the Competition at any time without notice or further recourse to the entrants.
