Track descriptions

- Adaptive compliant ascent and adventure track**
All trails will return to the top of the slope using a shared climbing trail to promote circular traffic flow and promote high capacity use.

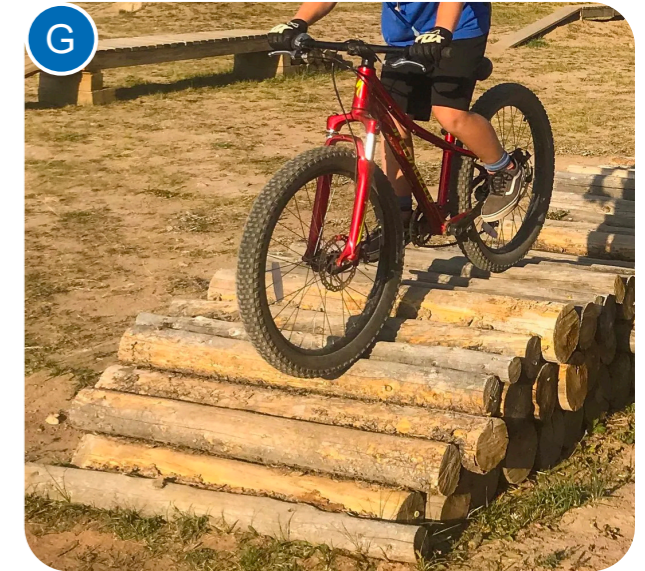
Designed to provide an inclusive off-road riding experience, the trail will be configured with adaptive mountain bike access in mind, including generous widths, smooth transitions and considered turning radii.
- Beginner skill level track**
Beginner trail follows most gradual gradient on site to manage speed and build confidence with ease.
- Intermediate skill level down hill track**
Progresses to increased gradient, offering more complex features to run down trail alignment.
- Advanced skill level down hill track**
For more experienced riders, the advanced track will offer challenges such as curved boardwalks, jumps and wall rides - emphasizing skill development for air time



Berm
Berm features are a fundamental component of a skills park, designed to help riders develop confidence and control when cornering at speed.



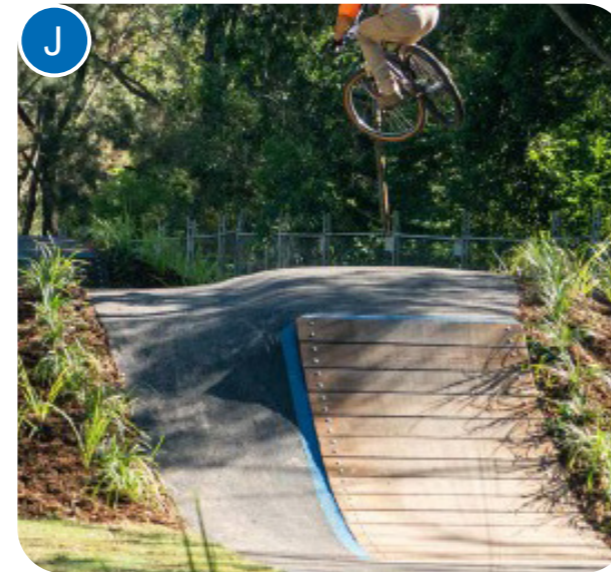
Rock pave and rock garden
Rock paved sections and rock gardens are designed to develop essential technical riding skills by introducing riders to uneven, naturalistic terrain in a controlled environment.



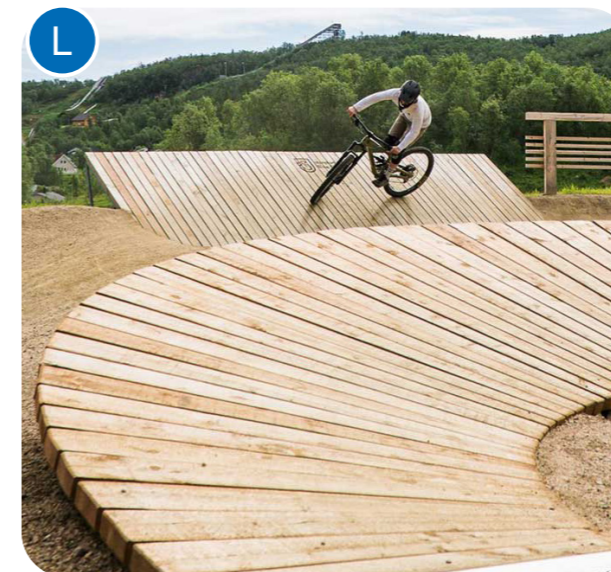
Log roller
Log roller obstacles are a core skills feature designed to build rider confidence in navigating natural trail challenges.



Drop trainer
Drop trainers are a purpose-built progression feature designed to help riders safely develop the skills required for controlled descents and drop-offs.



Jump
Jump features are a highly engaging element within a skills park, offering riders the opportunity to safely develop and refine their ability to achieve controlled airtime.



Curved technical boardwalk
Curved technical boardwalks are an advanced progression feature that builds on standard elevated riding elements by introducing curvature, height, and increased complexity.



Track Signage
The inclusion of signage is a key element of the Off Road Cycling Skills Track, guiding riders, indicating difficulty and hazards, and enhancing safety and navigation while minimising environmental impact.
