Project overview

Around 23,000 vehicles use this intersection every day. It connects to important local roads, including Pinelands Road and Beaudesert Road.

There are currently no safe crossing facilities for people walking, riding, or travelling to nearby schools, services, shops, and bus stops.

The proposed upgrade will install traffic lights and signalised pedestrian crossings to improve safety and accessibility, as well as improve traffic flow predictability.

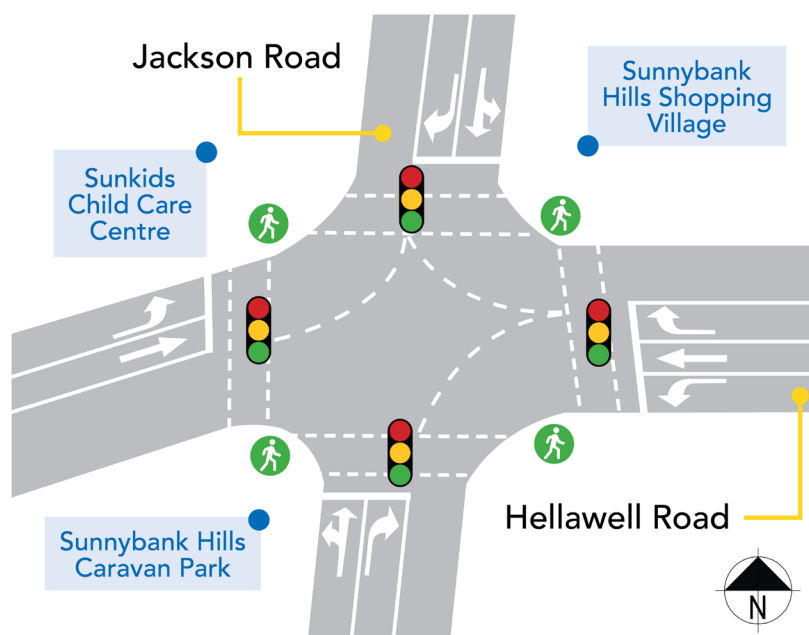

Project details

We have completed early planning and developed a draft design for the intersection upgrade. Before we move ahead, we want to hear from local residents, businesses, and people who travel through the area.

The proposed upgrade includes:

- new traffic lights at the intersection
- pedestrian crossings on all four sides of the intersection.

The proposed upgrade would also deliver:

- new sections of footpath
- better access to nearby bus stops
- road resurfacing and line marking
- minor landscaping improvements.



What's next?

Council values all feedback and is committed to listening to the local community. If results from the survey show the local community supports the project, it will proceed through to construction. However, if the survey reveals the community do not support the proposal, Council will review the project and consider the best next steps. We'll review all feedback and share what we've heard and any next steps later this year.
