## We're upgrading Minnie Street at Upper Kedron to better connect with Cedar Creek Road and improve traffic flow through to Rosella Street.

### Project overview

The works include realigning and widening Minnie Street to improve traffic flow into Rosella Street and adjusting the Cedar Creek Road intersection so vehicles can move more efficiently.

We'll add bike lanes along Minnie Street to connect to existing bike lanes on Cedar Creek Road and Rosella Street.

The footpath will be reconstructed to match the new street layout and we'll refresh road surfaces and line markings, with new turf and landscaping throughout the project area.

We're also exploring ways to reduce congestion at the McGinn Road and Mcalroy Road intersection to improve access and allow for future bus services into Upper Kedron.



### Next steps



We're committed to keeping you in the loop as we prepare to upgrade Minnie Street.

Construction will start in early 2026.
