

# MOGGILL ROAD CORRIDOR UPGRADE PROJECT

### Brisbane City Council is pleased to provide the community with a project update on the Moggill Road Corridor Upgrade Project.

Council recently announced further investment to upgrade one of Brisbane's busiest road corridors, Moggill Road. The Moggill Road Corridor Upgrade will alleviate congestion and improve safety for road users travelling through Brisbane's busy western suburbs with works to improve the overall operation of the corridor to help residents get home sooner and safer.

The Moggill Road Corridor Upgrade – Stage 1 project will incorporate the Indooroopilly Roundabout Upgrade Project, a joint initiative funded by Brisbane City Council and the Australian Government. The Georgiou Group has been awarded the main construction contract to deliver the upgrade now the removal of the former Audi dealership site is complete.

The Indooroopilly Roundabout Upgrade Project includes the construction of an overpass from Coonan Street over Moggill Road to improve overall intersection operation and safety for all road users as well as ensure it can cater for future traffic demands. Main construction works for the upgrade will commence in late 2021.

#### Key project benefits

- improve safety for road users and pedestrians at the intersection and nearby streets by allowing free-flowing traffic on Moggill Road
- improve traffic flow and reduce travel times with the construction of an overpass for vehicles on Coonan Street travelling to the CBD
- create more accessible active transport options by upgrading shared pedestrian and cycle paths, improving active travel opportunities and connectivity to shops, schools, public transport and essential services
- creating a greener space with new landscaping across the site.

Stage 2 of the Moggill Road Corridor Upgrade will further improve traffic conditions on Moggill Road maximising benefits of the Indooroopilly Roundabout Upgrade including:

- creating more accessible public transport by constructing new indented bus stops to move parked buses out of traffic lanes where possible
- various traffic flow improvements

#### Funding

The Moggill Road Corridor Upgrade is jointly funded by Brisbane City Council as part of the Better Roads for Brisbane program, and the Australian Government as part of the Urban Congestion Fund.

The project forms part of a joint \$500 million commitment to deliver congestion-busting projects and safety improvements across Brisbane.

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Main construction road works are scheduled to commence in late 2021. Local residents, businesses and road users will start to see an increase in activity in the area including:

### Establishment of the project site office and information centre

The project team will establish a site office in Indooroopilly, including community information centre. The information centre will be open throughout construction for the community to speak with a member of the project team about the upgrade. Further information on the location and opening hours will be provided to the community in the coming weeks.

### Commencement of construction activities

From November 2021, local residents, businesses and road users will notice increased construction activities throughout the site. Works will be carried out during the day between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday. Works will also be required to be undertaken at night when traffic volumes are lowest.

### Changed traffic conditions

Constructing the upgrade will require changed traffic conditions for road users travelling through the area. Traffic changes will include traffic control, lane closures, speed restrictions, and detours. Road users may experience delays when travelling through the area. Council will continue to monitor traffic conditions throughout the project and make adjustments where possible. Traffic control and signage will be in place to notify of changed conditions and to direct road users through the works.

### Initial construction activities

#### Stormwater drainage upgrade works

Will be undertaken throughout the project. Storm water drainage works will involve locating services, saw cutting and excavation of road surfaces to locate drainage pipes, and installation of new drainage pipes and manholes.

#### Public utility authorities

Will start their upgrade works from October 2021. Utility authorities will upgrade services such as gas, water and communication services.

#### Building removal works

In order to prepare for the main construction works, Council's contractor will remove a number of buildings from Council-owned land on Moggill Road from late 2021 onwards.

### Vegetation removal

Disappointingly, some large trees and other vegetation will need to be removed to facilitate the upgrade. At the completion of the project, approximately 30,000 plants, including advanced fig trees, pine and eucalypt trees, as well as groundcover vegetation, will be planted within the project area.

All tree and vegetation removal will be carried out in accordance with Council policies, including a 3 to 1 replacement ratio to achieve a no net canopy area loss following the end of construction. This is in addition to compliance with the relevant legislation and environmental guidelines, including a fauna spotter onsite during all clearing activities.

### Construction hours

- Construction will be carried out between **Monday and Saturday from 7am to 6pm**
- Night works will occur from **Sunday to Thursday 7:30pm to 5.30am**
- Council will provide advance notification of anticipated night works required throughout the construction period.
