

## Belgrave Road, Allwood Street and Coonan Street

As part of the project, we are upgrading the Belgrave Road and Coonan Street intersection. Traffic changes are required for the construction of a drainage chamber close to the middle of the intersection. Works to create a signalised left turn at Belgrave Street and a U-turn on Coonan Street will commence mid-2023.

More information will be provided to residents and commuters when timing for these works is confirmed.



## Taringa Parade and Moggill Road

From April, the community will also start to see minor works at the intersection of Taringa Parade and Moggill Road to extend the existing right-turn lane, modify the traffic island and limit turning movements at Jackson Street and Rylatt Street.



## Construction hours

- Construction will be carried out between **Monday and Saturday from 7am to 6pm.**
- Night works (when required) will occur **Sunday to Thursday 7:30pm to 5:30am.**

## Important project update

It is really exciting to see this city shaping project taking shape.

Council is getting on with the job of alleviating congestion and improving safety for all road users and helping residents get home quicker and safer.

A lot of work has been done to move the water, energy and telecommunications cables out of the way to allow the overpass to be built.

So far the project has laid:

- 3.5 kms of new Telstra cables
- 2.5 kms of new drainage pipes
- 1 km of new sewer pipes
- 3 kms of new water pipes
- 2 kms of underground Energex cabling
- 2.2kms of intelligent traffic systems network

To build the overpass 44,000 cubic metres (8800 truck loads) of soil will be removed from site and 9000 cubic metres (more than 17 Olympic size swimming pools) of concrete will be poured.

The overpass will use 1440 tonnes of reinforcement steel and 117 prestressed concrete overpass beams.

The Moggill Road Corridor Upgrade Project will ensure the people of Western Brisbane have reliable and safe access through this area.

I look forward to continuing to see this iconic project take shape.

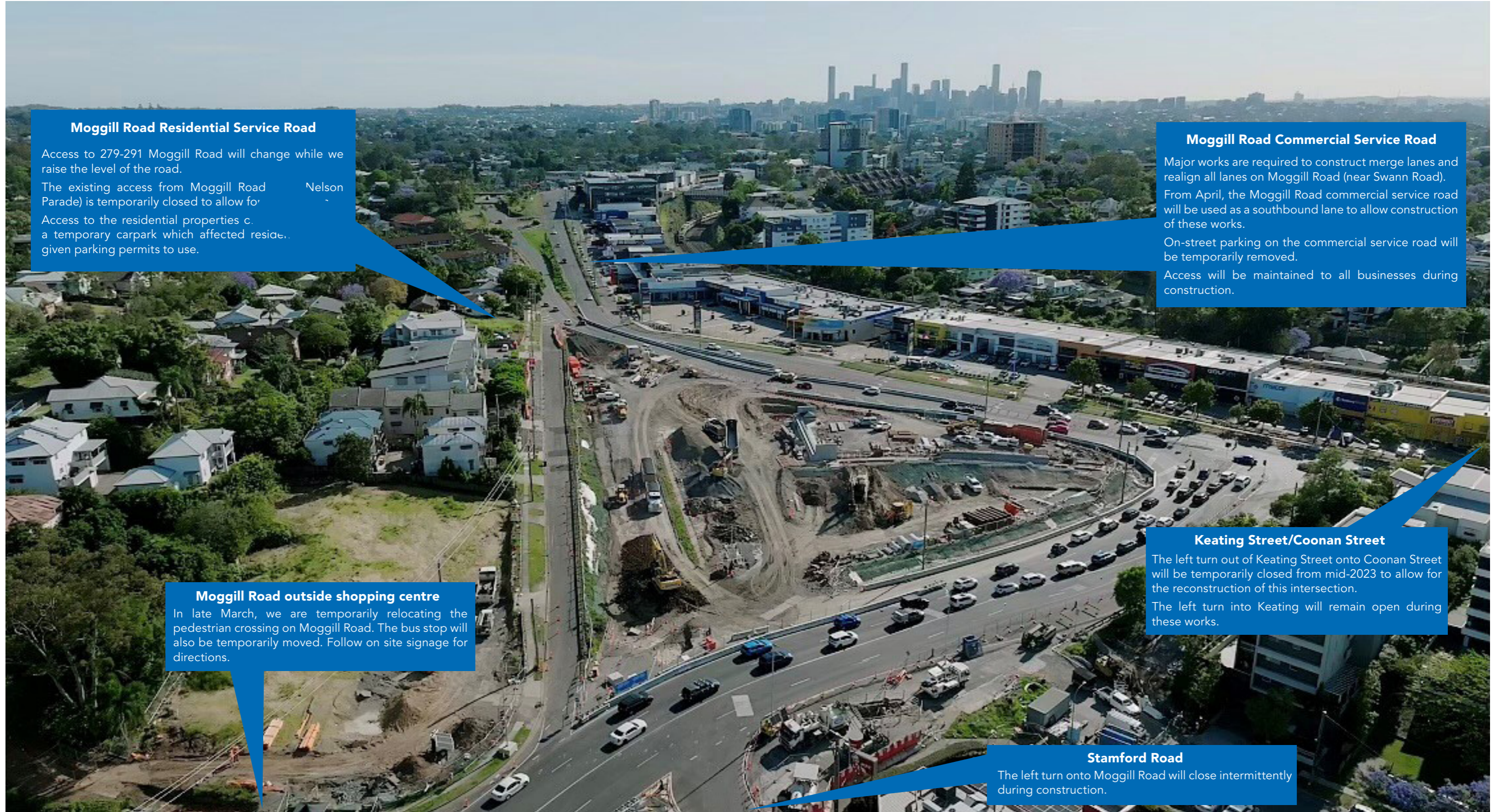

## Moggill Road Residential Service Road

Access to 279-291 Moggill Road will change while we raise the level of the road.

The existing access from Moggill Road (near Swann Road) is temporarily closed to allow for

## Moggill Road Commercial Service Road

Major works are required to construct merge lanes and realign all lanes on Moggill Road (near Swann Road).

From April, the Moggill Road commercial service road will be used as a southbound lane to allow construction of these works.

On-street parking on the commercial service road will be temporarily removed.

Access will be maintained to all businesses during construction.

## Moggill Road outside shopping centre

In late March, we are temporarily relocating the pedestrian crossing on Moggill Road. The bus stop will also be temporarily moved. Follow on site signage for directions.

## Keating Street/Coonan Street

The left turn out of Keating Street onto Coonan Street will be temporarily closed from mid-2023 to allow for the reconstruction of this intersection.

The left turn into Keating will remain open during these works.

## Stamford Road

The left turn onto Moggill Road will close intermittently during construction.
