

Mowbray Park Upgrade - Final Concept Plan

Legend

- 1** Multi-use community space with terraced steps, stage, and turfed open space.

2 Open kickabout space and picnic shelters that provide room for gatherings while maintaining views across the river.

3 Upgraded croquet club building.

4 Upgraded toilets accessible from playground and open space.

5 Relocated car park with shade trees, garden beds and a central landscaped area that helps manage rainwater.

6 Expand playground with new features for older kids.

7 Terraced lawn seating.

8 New accessible pathway connecting car park with croquet club and park.

9 New garden beds with colourful, low-growing plants that help keep views open through the park.

10 Retain and upgrade picnic facilities.

11 Reinstated bandstand designed as an open, contemporary structure with views to the river.

12 Existing revegetation area to be retained.

13 Opportunity for a new connecting path from Eskgrove Street.

14 Accessible parking retained for access to ferry terminal and lower riverside park areas.
