James Street, Doggett Street and Robertson Street safety improvements

We're planning to make changes to how you access James Street from Doggett Street and Robertson Street to make it safer for everyone.

Project overview

We're changing Doggett and Robertson Streets to left in and left out only. New traffic islands will be installed on Robertson Street and Doggett Street and the kerb extended out on 3 corners to allow for the new intersection layout.

We'll also widen the on-road cycle lanes and upgrade the line marking and signage at the intersection to make it safer for people riding through the intersection.

When will this work take place?

Works will be carried out at night when traffic and pedestrian volumes are lowest. This will ensure everyone's safety and reduce the overall time to complete the works.

Start	Mid-January 2026.
Finish	Mid-February 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.
Time/day	Night works 7pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday.

Improve safety for all road users



Improve connectivity for people walking and riding through the intersection



Improve intersection operation

Why are we doing this?

Between 2017 and 2024, there were 8 crashes at the intersection that resulted in one hospitalisation, 6 requiring medical treatment and one minor injury.

Restricting vehicle movements and upgrading facilities for people walking and riding will reduce the risk of crashes and make this intersection safer for everyone.


