Project update

June 2026



We're pleased to share the latest update on the Lindum rail crossing upgrade at Wynnum West.

Following community consultation in late 2024, we've been finalising the design for this important project and working closely with public utility authorities to carefully plan the complex infrastructure relocations required.

With the Lindum Station accessibility upgrade now complete, the project is ready to move into its next phase starting with relocating underground electrical cables. Energex will manage these relocations which are expected to begin in mid-June.

These early works are a key step in preparing the site ahead of major construction, which is planned to commence in mid 2027.

A message from the Lord Mayor

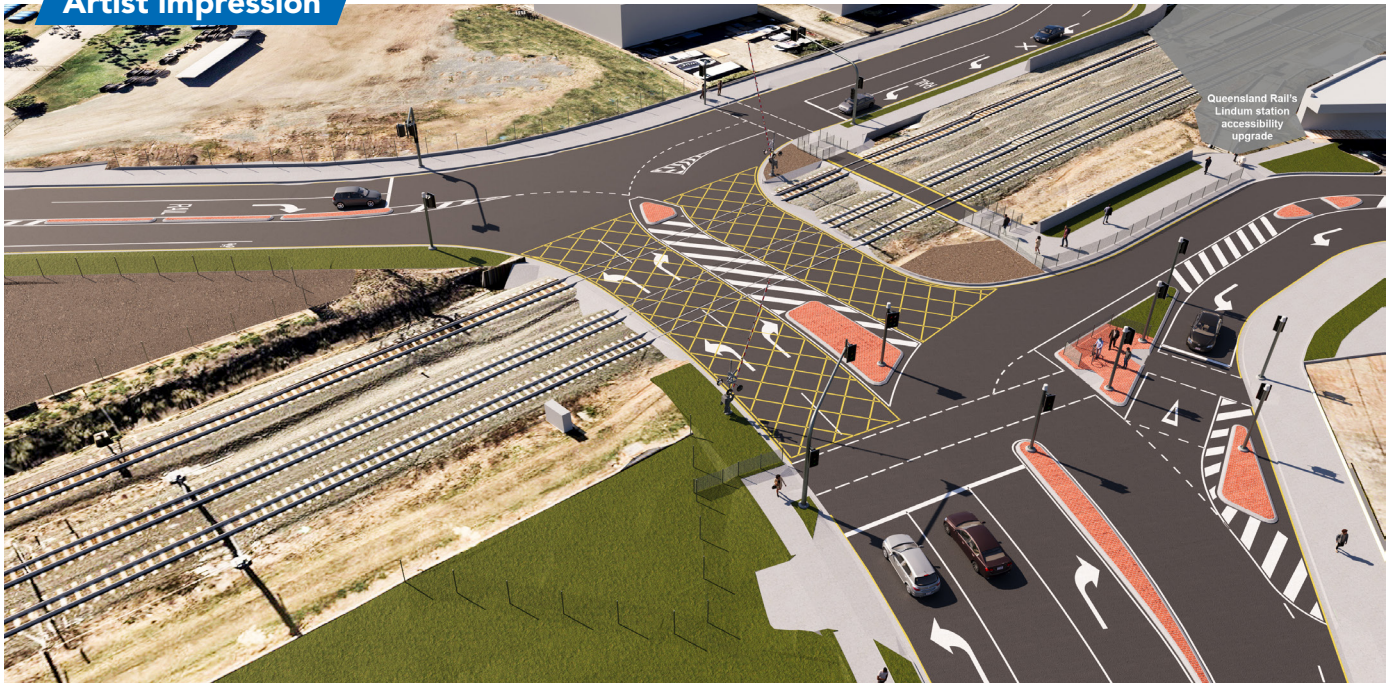
We're delivering the Lindum rail crossing upgrade to help residents get home sooner and safer. This important project will improve safety in the Lindum Station precinct by realigning the rail crossing, installing new signals, and making targeted changes to the way traffic moves through the area.

Project benefits



Improving safety for all road users

- Realigning the railway crossing to the west and reconfiguring the layout to achieve a perpendicular crossing will improve safety for all road users.
- Reducing the speed limit to 40kmph on all road approaches to the crossing.



Improving connectivity for people walking and riding

- New signalised pedestrian crossing facilities with shared paths and footpaths will improve active transport connectivity in conjunction with the new pedestrian connectivity provided by the upgrade of the Lindum Rail Station.



Improving intersection operation

- New traffic signals will control all movements through the crossing, including integration with the Queensland Rail boom gates.

What does this mean for me?

From mid-June you will see Energex and their contractors in the northern carpark of Lindum Rail Station and on Lindum Road working on the relocation of underground electrical cables. These works are expected to take three months to complete, depending on weather and site conditions.

Energex will need to temporarily occupy some carparks within the Lindum Rail Station and on Lindum Road. These will return to carparks when works are finished.

If there are any disruptions to electrical supply, Energex will notify impacted residents and businesses. There are not expected to be any changes to rail services as a result of these works.

More details about traffic changes and other community impacts will be provided closer to the start of main construction works.
