Kenmore Road Suburban Corridor Modernisation project

Project update

We're pleased to announce plans to improve safety and accessibility on Kenmore Road in Kenmore as part of our Suburban Corridor Modernisation (SCM) project are progressing.

The SCM program focuses on minor works at intersections to improve safety and accessibility for all road users.

What does this project involve?

Improvements for Kenmore Road include:

- 2 pedestrian refuge splitter islands and kerb ramps at the Kenmore Road and Gilruth Road roundabout
- upgraded kerb ramps on Crestview Street at Kenmore Road
- line marking and 2 traffic islands on the bend between 50 and 54 Kenmore Road
- upgrading existing lighting
- painting other associated line marking, including yellow 'No stopping' islands.

On-street parking will not be permitted where yellow 'No Stopping' lines are in place to ensure safe sightlines and appropriate visibility at crossing points and intersections, and to ensure lanes are wide enough for traffic to safely pass.

Off-road shared path

In response to feedback, Council is also undertaking initial investigations into the feasibility of an off-road shared path on Kenmore Road between the Centenary Motorway overpass and Sunset Road.

Potential improvements identified through this process will help to inform Council's future planning and design program, as we continue to work through investigations and upgrades in line with broader citywide objectives.

Why are we doing this?

This project will:

- improve pedestrian connectivity by providing safer and more accessible crossing points
- delineate traffic and encourage slower and safer vehicle movements
- improve visibility for all road users.

In 2022, the community provided feedback and supported various improvements along the Kenmore Road corridor as part of this project.

We used this feedback, along with our technical review, to progress designs for the key locations identified in this design.

Next steps

We are committed to keeping the community informed and will provide more information before construction starts in mid-2025.


