St Pauls Terrace safety improvements - Quarry Street to Gotha Street

Council is making changes along St Pauls Terrace, between Quarry Street and Gotha Street in Fortitude Valley, to make it safer for everyone.

What is changing?

We are installing new traffic signals, with pedestrian crossing facilities at the St Pauls Terrace and Quarry Street intersection. This will ensure all road users have dedicated time and space to travel through the intersection.

Warren Street will change to left-in only. You can access St Pauls Terrace from Warren Street via Barry Parade and Gotha Street.

We're also adding a new right turn arrow at the existing traffic signals to make turning from St Pauls Terrace into Gotha Street easier and safer.

Changes to on-street parking

We're removing some on-street parking on St Pauls Terrace and Quarry Street in the spaces marked with a yellow no stopping line and removing the motorcycle parking bay on Warren Street. This is to ensure appropriate sightlines for road users to travel safely through the intersection and maintain loading zone facilities.

Why is this happening?

Between 2017 and 2022, there were 12 reported crashes at the intersection, resulting in 6 hospitalisations, 4 requiring medical treatment and 2 minor injuries.

Eight of the crashes occurred when motorists turned right into or out of St Pauls Terrace without giving way, resulting in collisions with through traffic.

When will this work take place?

From mid-November 2025, we'll carry out early works to relocate a watermain on St Pauls Terrace, opposite Quarry Street. These works will take approximately 4 weeks to complete, weather and site conditions permitting.

Construction will start in early 2026. Most works will be carried out at night when traffic volumes are lowest.

We'll provide more information ahead of any works starting.
