Thynne Road near Kitson Street, Morningside Local Access Network Improvements

Project introduction

Project overview

We're pleased to announce plans to improve safety and access on Thynne Road near Kitson Street in Morningside.

What does this project involve?

Improvements for Thynne Road near Kitson Street will involve:

- installing a pedestrian refuge island and new kerb ramps on Thynne Road
- installing a pedestrian refuge splitter island and upgrading kerb ramps on Kitson Street
- upgrading small sections of footpath
- removal of 1 small tree to allow for the construction of a new kerb ramp
- completing minor turfing improvements
- painting new line marking, including yellow 'No Stopping' lines around the intersection.

On-street parking will not be permitted in spaces marked with yellow 'No Stopping' lines.

Why are we doing this?

This project will improve safety and access on Thynne Road and Kitson Street by:

- providing 2 new pedestrian refuge crossings
- upgrading kerb ramps to meet current accessibility standards
- improving pedestrian connectivity
- increasing sightlines and visibility for all road users
- delineating traffic and encouraging slower and safer vehicle movements.

Our Local Access Network Improvements program delivers important upgrades to ensure our suburbs are safe and accessible for all road users, particularly pedestrians.

We are committed to keeping the community informed and will provide more information before construction is anticipated to start in mid-2025.
