Project introduction

Project overview

We're pleased to announce plans to improve Toombul Road at St Vincents Road in Virginia as part of our Congestion Busting Projects.

Council is committed to reducing congestion across the city through a network-wide focus on traffic improvements to meet current and future traffic volumes along Brisbane's road network corridors.

What does this project involve?

Improvements for Toombul Road at St Vincents Road will involve:

- extending the right turn lane from Toombul Road into St Vincents Road
- constructing new road pavement within the extended lane
- installing associated line marking, including right turning arrows
- removal and replanting of 2 trees
- minor turfing.

Why are we doing this?

This project will:

- reduce congestion by increasing capacity of the right turn lane from Toombul Road into St Vincents Road
- reduce queueing and delays
- improve travel times and trip reliability.

Council's Congestion Busting Projects are about getting people home safer and more efficiently on roads that have higher volumes of traffic.

These projects focus on key changes to the road to improve the network efficiency.

Locations are chosen based on a number of factors including safety, visibility and overall network efficiency.
