

Victor Grenning Park remediation

Next steps and Have your say – September 2026

Project update

Earlier this year, we let the community know that historic asbestos contamination had been found beneath the soil at Victor Grenning Park during works to upgrade the playground shade sail.

Follow-up testing found asbestos at varying depths across the park, which meant we needed to develop a remediation plan for the entire site.

We're now in the final stages of getting ready for these works, with construction expected to begin in the coming months. Before work starts, we'll share more information about timing, what you can expect during construction, and any temporary changes in and around the park.

What's involved?

Our works will involve 2 stages: **remediation and reinstatement**.

In the **remediation** stage, we'll:

- remove the playground and all other fixtures
- remove all trees in the park
- excavate contaminated soil and old fill material, including the asbestos, across the whole park
- ensure the asbestos and fill is safely managed and removed by licensed contractors.

Following this, we'll **reinstate** the park and features, including:

- installing a new like-for-like playground and shade sail
- reinstating park amenities like shelters and the water bubbler
- planting new trees
- laying new turf and landscaping.

These works are expected take up to 12 months to complete.

The park and its features and amenities will be reinstated like-for-like, but there's still an opportunity for you to help shape parts of the space.

We're inviting your feedback on some key elements of the future playground and park, including preferred theme and ideas for tree planting.
