We're planning important upgrades to Milton Road, Croydon Street and Sylvan Road, with improvements along Sylvan Road and at key intersections to give you more options to travel and make your future journeys smoother and safer.

What we heard in June 2025

Walking and cycling is the top choice



Respondents prefer walking and cycling through the precinct, followed by driving.

Shared travel challenges



Everyone faces similar challenges, avoiding crashes, unsafe turning movements, and limited crossing options.

Unified vision for travel improvements



There's strong agreement on the top priorities to improve travel: separated facilities, safer crossings, and slower speeds.

Across the community, we heard strong shared support for a separated bikeway and safety concerns about current vehicle movements. You can read more about feedback on Sylvan Road and key intersections over the page.

How you travel

What's next?

We're working towards concept design for a bikeway on Sylvan Road and improvements at key intersections to support safer movements for everyone. The feedback you have shared will help shape the project, alongside technical data and engineering requirements.

We expect to be able to share information about concept designs in early 2026, with detailed design to follow later in the year. Construction timing will depend on how the design progresses, and we'll keep you updated as the project moves forward.

Below is an indicative timeline for the project, subject to change.




Project funding

What we heard about Sylvan Road

There is strong support for a separated bikeway.



- **94%** would feel **very safe** or **somewhat safe** travelling along Sylvan Road if a separated bikeway was installed
- **93%** said a separated bikeway on Sylvan Road would have a **very positive** or **positive effect** on your travel experience

What we heard about intersections along Sylvan Road and Milton Road

Key intersection	Summary of feedback
Sylvan Road, Croydon Street and Jephson Street	We heard strong support for intersection improvements, with concerns about safety, limited crossing options, narrow bike lanes and conflicts with vehicles.
Milton Road, Croydon Street and Morley Street	Many support improving this intersection to make it safer and more efficient for everyone, especially when crossing the road or turning left onto Milton Road.
Milton Road and Sylvan Road	There was strong support for separated facilities and safer crossings, especially for people accessing the shared path on Milton Road.

General feedback themes

• Dedicated, separated bikeway

Many people asked for dedicated, separated cycle facilities on Sylvan Road and Land Street.

• Intersection improvements

Detailed feedback for ways to improve intersections on Sylvan Road, including improving or providing more priority crossings for walking, cycling, and scooting.

• Improving the street experience

Suggestions to make Sylvan Road more pedestrian friendly with wider footpaths, more crossings, and slower speeds.

• Parking sentiment

Most support changes to current parking arrangements on Sylvan Road to accommodate the bikeway, with suggestions to retain street parking on one side of Sylvan Road.
