What works are coming up?

We're starting upgrade works at Bulimba Library to create a more welcoming, functional and enjoyable space for the community.

When will this work take place?

Start	20 July 2026
Finish	Late 2026
Time and day	6:30am-6:30pm, Monday to Friday, with Saturday works as required

What does this work include?

As part of the Bulimba Library upgrade, we are:

- refreshing internal layouts with new lounge, study and quiet reading areas
- improving accessibility, including a new unisex accessible toilet, a new PWD car park space at the front of the library and upgraded entry doors
- replacing the roof and high-level windows
- improving internal comfort
- upgrading internal building services and amenities.

Where will the works be?

Most works will be inside Bulimba Library on the corner of Riding Road and Oxford Street.

The map over the page shows areas outside the library that will be impacted temporarily during construction. We'll provide clear signage onsite throughout the works.

Why is this work happening?

This upgrade is about creating a better experience for the community.

The improvements focus on giving the Bulimba Library a more modern look and feel, providing more reading and seating spaces for you to study, work and read, improved accessibility and bathroom facilities.

What does this mean for me?

Bulimba Library will be closed, and a temporary library will operate from Bulimba Bowls Club at 6 Quinn Street, Balmoral.

Between late July and early August, there will be two days of crane operations on Riding Road near the library. For safety reasons, there will be intermittent footpath closures outside school drop-off and pick-up times.

Between late August and mid-September, there will be more footpath closures on Oxford Street outside the library.

During these intermittent footpath closures, a detour will be in place. Please follow the direction of signage and traffic controllers. Some noise, dust and increased vehicle movement is expected, but we will work to minimise disruption where possible.
