

James Warner and C.T. White Parks remediation project

Construction update – August 2026

Remediation works will continue from next week at James Warner Park and we'll be **starting work in C.T. White Park from early September 2026**.

Works will involve taking out old fill material under the soil and replacing it. This work will help us protect our environment and the spaces that make Brisbane's lifestyle even better.

What to expect?

If you live in or travel through the area, you may notice:

- increased construction activity and noise during work hours
- some temporary closures of Council car parks on Hamilton Street.

Hamilton Street will be closed intermittently during the initial stages of work in C.T. White Park. Signage will be onsite and residents can see traffic control to exit and enter the street.

The playground in C.T. White Park will be **closed for up to 4 months from early September** while we remediate the area. After works are complete, the playground will be reinstated slightly to the north of the current location to improve accessibility.

Additional remediation work

Asbestos has been identified in the ground in some areas of both parks while our works have been underway. As part of this project, it will be safely managed and removed by licensed contractors, with appropriate signage and controls in place to ensure community safety. The licensed contractor may contact nearby residents ahead of the removal works.

Due to recent wet weather and this additional remediation work, the works in James Warner Park will take longer to complete and the **dog park is currently expected to remain closed until December**. We'll let you know a more specific re-opening date as works progress as this is subject to weather and site conditions.

Bikeway and pathway closures

Sections of the bikeway in the park and footpath on the western side of Hamilton Street will be closed intermittently **during the initial stages of work in C.T. White Park**. When closed, signage will be installed and a detour will be in place on the eastern side of Hamilton Street.
