Pallara District Sports Park

Early works

We're completing early works for the Pallara District Sports Park project at 65 Van Dieren Road, Pallara. This work will prepare us for main construction works on the new sports park later this year.

When will this work take place?

Start	Early April 2026
Finish	Mid-2026
Time and day	7am to 5pm, Monday to Saturday

What does this work include?

To support the main construction works, we'll be getting started with:

- building new kerb and channel and footpath on Van Dieren Road from Navarre Street to opposite Emerald Street
- removing some street trees and shrubs from the frontage of 65 Van Dieren Road
- planting 27 new street trees.
- installing a new stormwater outlet pipe in J.M Sullivan Park and trench across Van Dieren Road to connect to the sports park.

What does this mean for me?

For the first 5 weeks of work, Van Dieren Road will be fully closed to through traffic between Prominence Street and Emerald Street during working hours.

Access to private properties will remain available at all times. Please follow detour signs and traffic control.

School bus stops will be temporarily relocated just outside the closure area. The new stop locations will be clearly signed and are only a short walk from the usual stops. Bus timetables will stay the same, and buses will use the signed detour route.

We'll provide another update after this closure period with details on working times and traffic arrangements for remaining works.

If you live in or travel through the area, you may also notice a site compound established in J.M Sullivan Park and increased construction activity and noise during work hours.
