Toowong intersection improvements and Sylvan Road bikeway

Start of construction at the Milton Road, Croydon Street and Morley Street intersection

What works are coming up?

We're starting works at the Milton Road, Croydon Street and Morley Street intersection to improve safety and traffic flow from Croydon Street onto Milton Road westbound.

When will this work take place?

Start	Early August 2026
Finish	Early 2027, weather and site conditions permitting
Time and day	7pm to 5am, Sunday to Thursday

To keep everyone at this busy intersection safe and minimise daytime traffic disruption, works will take place at night when traffic is lighter. Some works may take place during the day between Monday to Friday, 7am to 5pm.

What does this work include?

As part of these works, we will:

- add a dedicated left turn lane from Croydon Street onto Milton Road
- relocate stormwater infrastructure from Croydon Street to Caddell Street
- remove the right turn from Morley Street onto Milton Road to improve outbound flow from Croydon Street to Milton Road
- change traffic signal timings
- install a new raised zebra crossing in the left turn slip lane from Milton Road onto Croydon Street for safer movements
- upgrade boarding facilities at outbound bus stop 13 Milton Road at Morley Street
- reconstruct the footpath and build a small retaining wall near the corner of Croydon Street and Milton Road
- relocate public utility services
- remove some vegetation on Croydon Street and re-plant within the area.

Why is this work happening?

In May 2026, we shared 2 concept designs for the Toowong intersection improvements and Sylvan Road bikeway project.

Both options aim to reduce traffic along Sylvan Road between Milton Road and Jephson Street/Croydon Street. This will help create a slower, safer environment in this busy area, which includes homes, businesses and a primary school.

The designs also include confirmed upgrades at the Milton Road, Croydon Street and Morley Street intersection. With less traffic expected on Sylvan Road once the bikeway is built, these changes will improve traffic flow from Croydon Street onto Milton Road westbound and help keep outbound traffic moving.

The works will also make it safer for people to approach and cross at the signalised intersection and provide more space at outbound bus stop 13 to wait and get on and off the bus.

We're starting work at this location first to deliver these benefits sooner and support the smooth delivery of the overall project.

Project funding

This project is jointly funded by the Australian Government and Brisbane City Council.

What do these works mean for me?

If you live in or are travelling through the area, you may notice:

- construction vehicles with reversing alarms and flashing lights
- noise and dust from saw cutting, excavation and potential jackhammering
- traffic controllers and signage to safely guide you
- temporary lane closures and some traffic delays
- a site compound on the corner of Milton Road and Croydon Street
- signage directing you to a nearby temporary bus stop for a short time while outbound bus stop 13 is upgraded.

We value your patience and cooperation while we undertake this important project.

What's next for the project?

We're currently considering your feedback alongside technical requirements on the 2 concept designs for a separated bikeway on Sylvan Road and Land Street, as well as nearby intersection improvements.

We expect to share a final concept design in the coming months. The adopted concept design will be further refined through the detailed design process, with construction undertaken in stages.

Works for the Sylvan Road bikeway are planned to start in 2027, subject to detailed design progress. Timing for works on Land Street will be confirmed after detailed design and budget confirmation.

We'll keep you updated as the project moves forward. Below is an indicative timeline for the project, subject to change

Improved intersections

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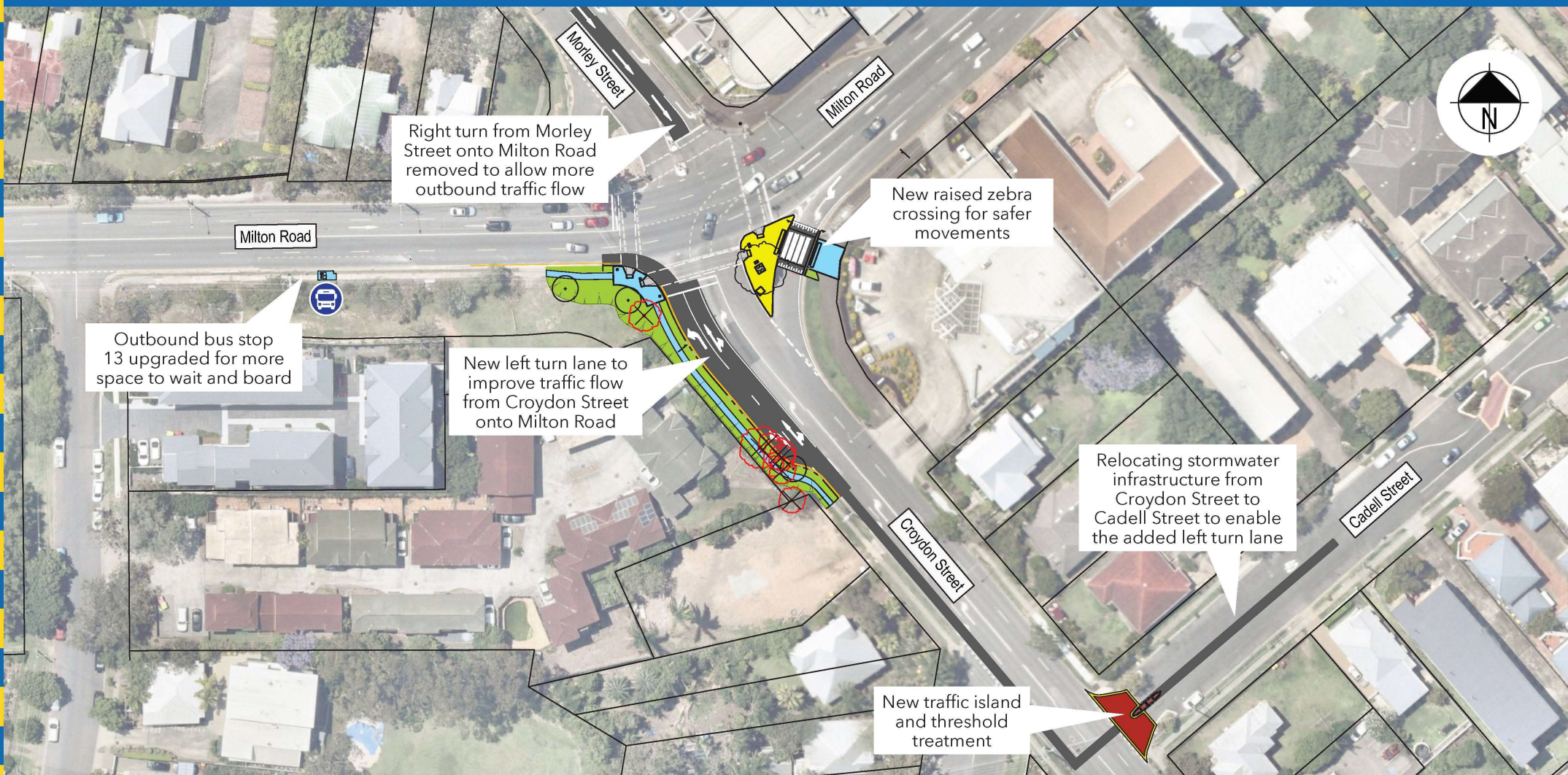


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Milton Road, Croydon Street and Morley Street intersection
