What does this involve?

- Widening the roadway to provide a consistent median separated 4-lane carriageway.
- Extending culverts across Cabbage Tree Creek.
- Constructing a new shared pedestrian underpass.
- Upgrading sections of shared path on Beams Road.
- Upgrading 2 bus stops on Beams Road.

Initial works will involve establishing the site compound, traffic management setup, conducting survey works around the area, initial demolition works and clearing vegetation and trees within the project area.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Carselgrove Avenue and Handford Road during works.

When do works start?

Works will begin on Beams Road, between Carselgrove Avenue and Handford Road, in June 2025 and are expected to be completed in late 2026, weather and site conditions permitting.

What does this mean for you?

During the works you may notice:

- temporary traffic disruptions and Beams Road reduced to one lane in each direction from Carselgrove Avenue to Handford Road
- construction activity including noise, dust and vibrations
- temporary bus stops during works
- night works as required.

Traffic control and signage will be present onsite. Safety is of the utmost importance to Council and we will work with the Principal Contractor to ensure we prioritise safety and minimise disruptions during the delivery of works.

Interface with nearby works

Brisbane City Council is continuing to work closely with the Department of Transport and Main Roads' Beams Road rail level crossing project.

We will continue to interface our work areas to ensure the impact to traffic is minimised.

Brisbane City Council has been working hard to improve Beams Road for the broader community and we are excited to announce the start of construction of this next stage of works.

Beams Road is an arterial road carrying both suburban traffic flow and heavy vehicles for freight. It also serves as a key connector between suburbs and provides access to Gympie Arterial Road.

The first stage of the Beams Road upgrade, between Lacey Road and Balcara Avenue, was completed in early 2025 and included removing the existing roundabout at Dorville Road and Beams Road and replacing it with traffic signals, upgrading and widening the roadway in key sections and improving shared path connections.

Following the successful completion of the first stage of works, Council is now improving safety and reducing congestion between Carselgrove Avenue and Handford Road.

Project benefits



Improved traffic flow - Removing the bottleneck at Cabbage Tree Creek by upgrading this section of road to 2 lanes in each direction.



Enhanced safety and accessibility New shared paths and pedestrian underpass will provide a safe and separate space for people walking and riding to travel along the Cabbage Tree Creek Bikeway.



Environmental benefits - A combination of new trees, shrubs and ground covers will be replanted as part of the works. New creek culvert infrastructure will improve the downstream outlet to Cabbage Tree Creek.

Bus stop changes

We're upgrading 2 bus stops along Beams Road to improve safety, accessibility and comfort. These upgrades will support public transport use in the area.

Upgrades will be completed at:

- bus stop 011233 Beams Road at Holy Spirit College.
- bus stop 011241 Beams Road at Golden Downs.

Temporary bus stops may be in place throughout works.





Pedestrian access

We are improving shared paths as part of the project. Path upgrades will be made to sections of footpath in the project area to improve connectivity for people walking and riding.

Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times. If you are walking through the area, one side of the path will be closed off at various points as we move our work zone and for your safety.

Onsite signage and traffic control will be in place to help you move safely through the area.
