

# How to extend or renew an application – Road Corridor Permit System

The Road Corridor Permit System (RCPS) is a safe and reliable online portal that streamlines the application process for road and off-road bikeway closures.

To extend or renew a current permit, you need to apply for an extension.

The RCPS makes this easier by allowing you to clone the original application details to prefill most of the renewal application fields.
