1.0 GENERAL

The *Standard Drawings* (Brisbane City Council, 2001) supersede the 1994/95 Works Department publication. Standard Drawings depict default construction layouts and details of infrastructure assets that are acceptable to Brisbane City Council.

The Standard Drawings are categorised into series and sub-series, which also contain a number of discrete drawings. The designated identification system:

- Provides logical itemised work groupings.
- Provides unique reference number for each drawing.
- Provides flexibility to add or remove drawings.

2.0 HOW TO GET A COPY

The current edition of the Standard Drawings set is available for free download on the Brisbane City Council Website. To access this document, follow these steps:

1. Go to Ourbrisbane.com (www.ourbrisbane.com).
2. Click on the "Visit Brisbane City Council Website" link on the left of page.
3. Once in the Brisbane City Council Website (<http://www.brisbane.qld.gov.au>), click "Business" drop down menu from top access bar.
4. Select "Building and development".
5. Select "Subdivision and development" from the side menu.
6. Access the Standard Drawings from the quick link menu at top of page or from the links in the text.

Hardcopies may be purchased from the Central Business Centre (Library and Customer Centre, Brisbane Square, 266 George Street, Brisbane) or the local Regional Business Centre.

3.0 COPYRIGHT

The copyright of the Standard Drawings is vested in Brisbane City Council. However the Standard Drawings may be incorporated into tender and contract documents for the following works either physically and/or by reference. If documents are incorporated by reference alone, it will be necessary to quote the edition date.

- Work to be constructed for Council.
- Work in a development to be contributed to Council.
