Notice of adoption of a Temporary Local Planning Instrument to the Brisbane City Plan 2000 Pursuant to Step 6.2A of Stage 3 of Part 4 of the Statutory Guideline 01/12 Making and amending local planning instruments (Guideline) made under the *Sustainable Planning Act 2009* by including Temporary Local Planning Instrument 01/12

At its meeting of 16 May 2012, Council adopted amendments to the Brisbane City Plan 2000 to introduce *Temporary Local Planning Instrument 01/12 Brisbane Interim Flood Response*. The Temporary Local Planning Instrument applies to land affected by the January 2011 flooding, as well as by waterway or creek floods.

Purpose and General Effect

The Temporary Local Planning Instrument will provide improved guidance and certainty for the community about residential development and building in flood-affected areas. The Temporary Local Planning Instrument commenced on 16 May 2012 and will cease to have effect on 15 May 2013. It replaces *Temporary Local Planning Instrument 01/11 Brisbane Interim Flood Response*.
