A public transport solution to get you home quicker and safer



Brisbane City Council's new Brisbane Metro will cut travel times, reduce congestion and put more buses in the suburbs. It's all part of Council's plan to get residents home quicker and safer with more travel options, less congestion and better public transport.

Delivering the first stage of Brisbane Metro will mean a 21 kilometre, turn-up-and-go service with two dedicated lines, connecting 18 stations from Eight Mile Plains to Roma Street and Royal Brisbane and Women's Hospital (RBWH) to University of Queensland (UQ).

A message from Lord Mayor Graham Quirk

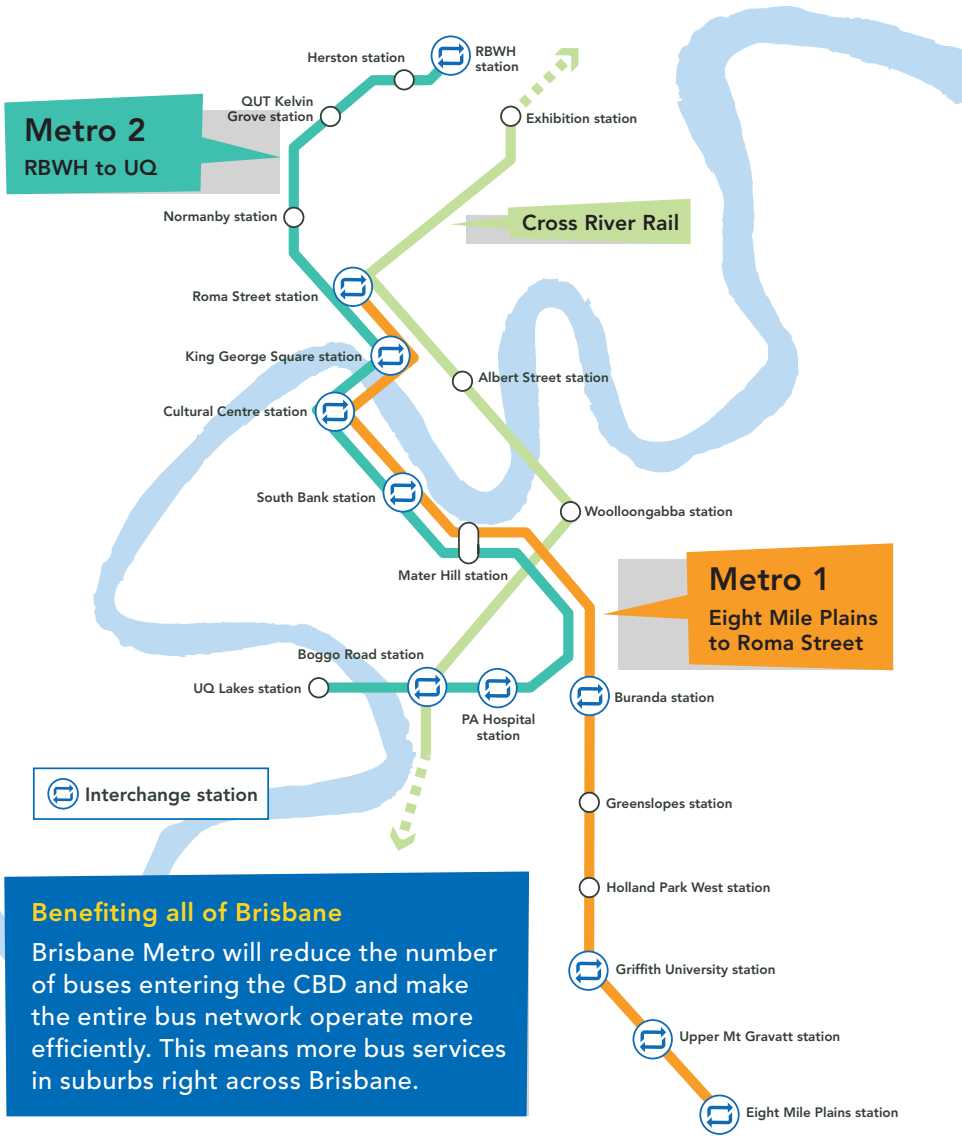
Following our latest newsletter, I am now able to give you significant updates on developments with the Brisbane Metro project over the past few months and our plans moving forward.

This newsletter contains the benefits of this exciting new project, which will provide public transport opportunities for those on the two Metro lines and for residents throughout Brisbane.

The Metro will operate every three minutes in peak periods, and this higher capacity service will mean more buses can be diverted to create additional services in suburbs right across our city.

The construction of the Metro is now fully funded, and we have commenced the procurement process.
