

FREW PARK

FINAL CONCEPT PLAN – March 2012



- 1 Vehicle entry point to park.
- 2 Main path entrance to connect with existing crossing point to link with Gregory Park.
- 3 Secondary path entrance to park.
- 4 Two-way sealed access road.
- 5 Landscaped buffer treatment to screen carpark, with adequate drainage to ensure flood impacts do not increase for residents.
- 6 Primary pathway through park lit for night time thoroughfare.
- 7 Carpark with 50 spaces for park use to ensure minimal impact on local street parking. It will be designed and managed to prevent commuter parking.
- 8 Vehicle turnaround and two-minute set down area.
- 9 Purpose-built, interactive, daytime play space to cater primarily for children aged 10-15. The facility will provide a wide range of play experiences with different activities to suit different interests and abilities. A separate smaller area for younger children will also be provided.
- 10 Long shelter with picnic tables and seating.
- 11 Shared amenities and proshop building including toilets and undercover meeting space on ground level and proshop and public recreation deck on the upper level. A future lessee may be able to consider a simple food and beverage service here.
- 12 Pathway connection to Milton Road.
- 13 Flexible multi-use sports pavement e.g. tennis rebound wall, half-court basketball, volleyball, yoga.
- 14 Six full-size tennis courts for day and possibly evening use, leased by private or community organisation. Possible artistic treatment of fence to provide visual interest from Milton Road.
- 15 Views to existing advertising billboard to be maintained.
- 16 Large grassed open space area (maximum 130m long and 80m wide) for informal daytime sport and recreation.
- 17 Pathway connection to Milton Road to connect with existing signalised crossing point to link with Milton Park.
- 18 Shaded plaza area with seating.
- 19 Small shaded picnic nodes.
- 20 Shade tree planting with majority of native bird-attracting species (locations of all trees are indicative only).
- 21 Secondary more natural pathway through park, forming part of internal circuit pathway (approx. 360m long).
- 22 Large picnic shelter spaces with tables and BBQs.
- 23 Possible future community garden site.
