Request to Plant Street Trees

Creating a clean, green Brisbane

Thank you for contacting Brisbane City Council requesting a full street planting in your area.

Council is committed to greening Brisbane as part of its *Living in Brisbane 2026* vision for a 'clean, green city'. A number of tree planting initiatives have been implemented, including community planting days as part of an ongoing street planting program.

To enable the success of the program, Council encourages community involvement. This has a number of benefits, as local resident's claim 'ownership' of the trees by having a part in planting and maintaining the trees. The success of street tree planting is usually governed by the extent of community participation to assist in establishing and caring for new trees.

Council will only plant trees where a resident has requested a tree to be planted on their footpath or as part of a street tree planting community program.

To assist in processing your tree planting request, we have provided a form to help you collect the names of residents in your area who will support the planting of a tree on their footpath.

Once Council receives the completed form, an inspector will assess the proposed planting sites to ensure compliance with Council's *Tree Planting Policy* and select a suitable tree species.

Residents may also request individual trees to be planted on their footpath by phoning Council on 3403 8888.
