INDOOROOPILLY RIVERWALK Construction update – May 2020

Brisbane City Council encourages active transport and is committed to providing quicker and safer travel options for residents and visitors.

The completed Indooroopilly Riverwalk will be a high quality, separated two-way cyclist and pedestrian riverwalk that takes advantage of the Brisbane River outlook. The Riverwalk will improve active transport through the area, with a safe and accessible route from Twigg Street to the Jack Pesch Bridge and the Indooroopilly Rail Station, and connections to Radnor Street and Riverview Terrace.

INDOOROOPILLY RIVERWALK Construction update – May 2020

General

Safety reminder: In order to facilitate construction activities and ensure the safety of road users and workers, there will be speed limit reductions around work zones, lane closures, detours and some minor traffic delays during off-peak and peak hours. Traffic controllers and signage will be in place as required to safely direct motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

Temporary single lane closures are currently operating on Radnor Street and Witton Road between Riverview Terrace and Twigg Street from **9am until 4pm, Monday to Saturday**. Traffic controllers are on site to guide road users safely through the work site under stop/go conditions at a reduced speed of 40km/hour through this area.

Construction hours: Construction activities will generally be undertaken **Monday to Saturday between 7am and 5pm**. Residents will receive advance notification of any out-of-hours works requirements.
