

Manly Harbour Village Precinct Project – Community feedback

Brisbane City Council held a second community engagement session on 7 February 2021 at Little Bayside Park in Manly to seek your feedback on the proposed concept design for the Manly Harbour Village Precinct Project. More than 50 people visited the onsite kiosk to speak to the project team and the community was invited to join artist Delvene Cockatoo-Collins in a twining workshop activity as part of the creative lighting options.

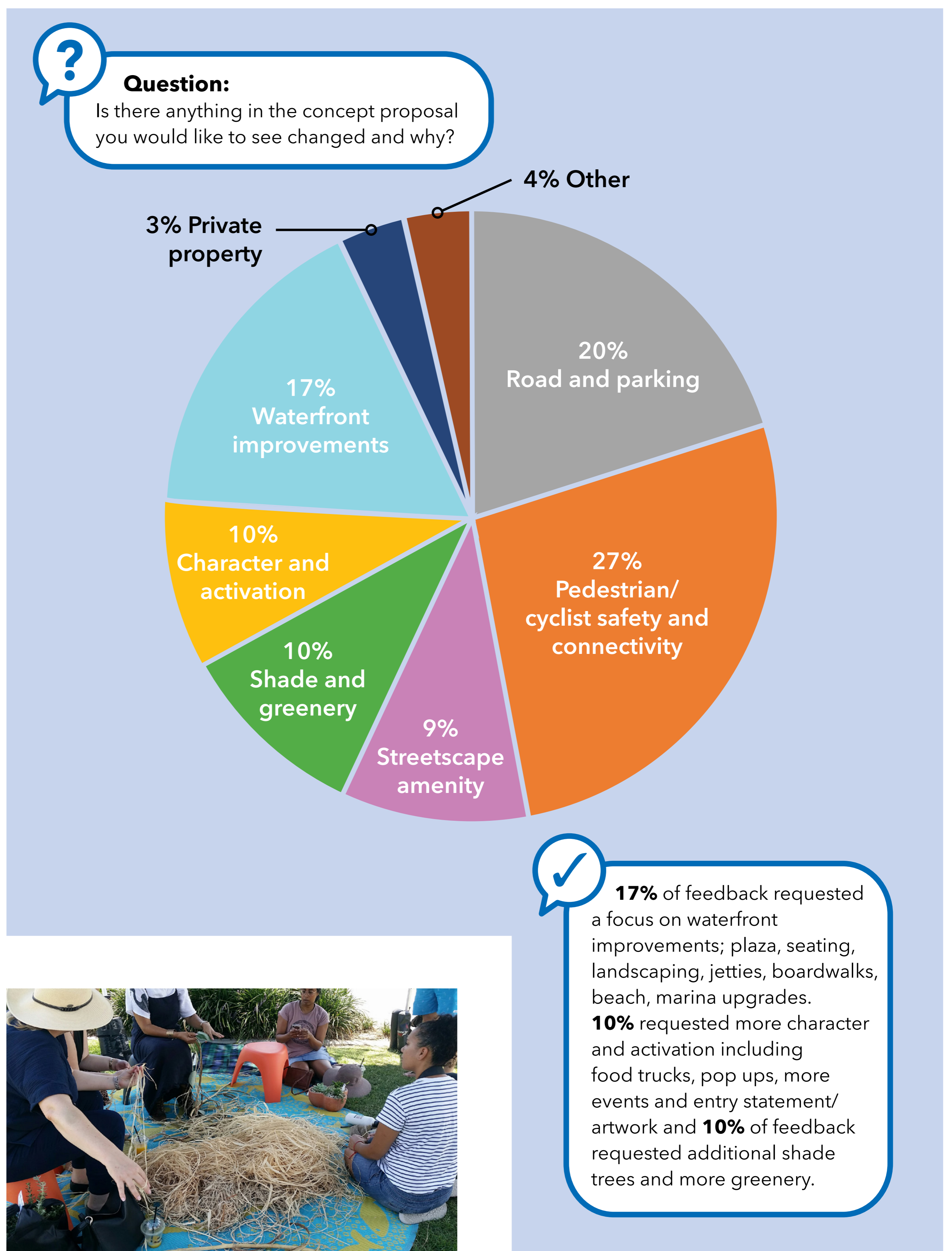
When participants were asked to rank aspects of the design, the foreshore plaza area was identified as the highest priority zone of the initial concept proposal.

Formal submissions were also received that identified concerns with traffic issues and intersection works.

Foreshore plaza

In response to the community feedback and submissions, the final improvement plan now focuses on the new foreshore plaza area. The improvements will create a more functional plaza layout, with a mix of high-quality pavement upgrades to enhance pedestrian movement and support festival and market uses.

The revised plan will include: a new lockable general power outlet (GPO) for event uses; bespoke concrete seating around garden bed edges with integrated LED lighting, new shade trees and refreshed garden beds; removal of ageing placemaking elements (colourful sail items and metal screens); and expanded creative lighting with local artist Delvene Cockatoo-Collins-designed projection artworks.
