

Mowbray Park Draft Concept Plan



Dedicated to a better Brisbane



The draft concept plan proposes to:

- expand the existing playground
- reinstate a bandstand
- upgrade and expand pathway network
- upgrade picnic and seating facilities
- plant new shade trees and reinstate former planting avenues
- improve park user safety by redirecting cyclists away from playground
- upgrade pathway lighting where needed
- install new garden beds with native and colourful vegetation
- retain the car park and review parking times
- upgrade toilet facilities
- create a new grassed area with tiered seating near the playground
- replace the bowls club site with open greenspace
- install creative lighting to activate the park in the evening.

1 Existing shared pathway along riverside to become the main connecting path for commuter and recreational cyclists.

2 Existing car park.

3 New garden beds with colourful plants at key locations throughout the park.

4 Upgraded public amenities viewable from playground and open space, and accessible from car park.

5 New open greenspace with large shade trees.

6 New pathway to connect to northern side of the park.

7 Grassed slope to transition between park levels, provides informal seating and views to the park.

8 Existing playground to be extended to the south.

9 Retain and upgrade picnic facilities. Furniture to be located on southern side of the shared pathway. Install creative lighting to activate park in the evening.

10 Reinstall bandstand as open contemporary structure. Placement takes advantage of river views.

11 Existing vegetation to be retained.

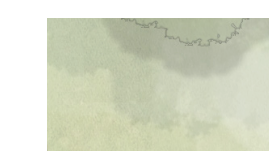
12 Opportunity for new connecting path from Eskgrove Street.
